Elizabeth's progress highlights the transformational role of Jubilee. Frontline workers improve the daily lives of people with disabilities. Managers provide quality oversight and help determine life goals. Additional staff plan programs that build community. It takes a team to change people's lives.

198 people with intellectual and developmental disabilities trusted Jubilee for support. Gia Richmond joined Jubilee as Director of Program Services. She oversees residential support managers and frontline workers.



18 people moved into new homes and apartments thanks to our Housing Support Services. Sharon was at risk of becoming homeless. Our housing team cut through red tape to help her get a place to live. Sharon is the first person to get Maryland's new rent subsidy for people with disabilities.



170 activities and special events that foster friendship, create leadership activities, teach life skills and build community. Guests filled Kensington's Town Hall to cheer on Davin singing and 32 other Jubilee community members who wowed us with their talents at our Variety Show.



105 new people navigated disability services with help from Breaking Barriers. Lillian got her government benefits back and now can afford an apartment. She gets direct support from Jubilee's staff to meet her life goals. Our bilingual program manager keeps her mom informed.
